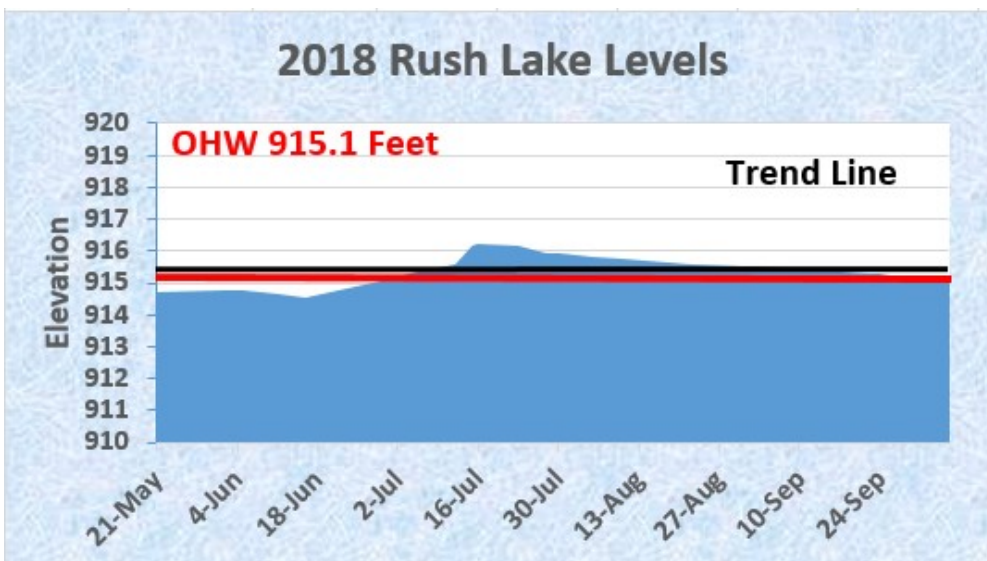
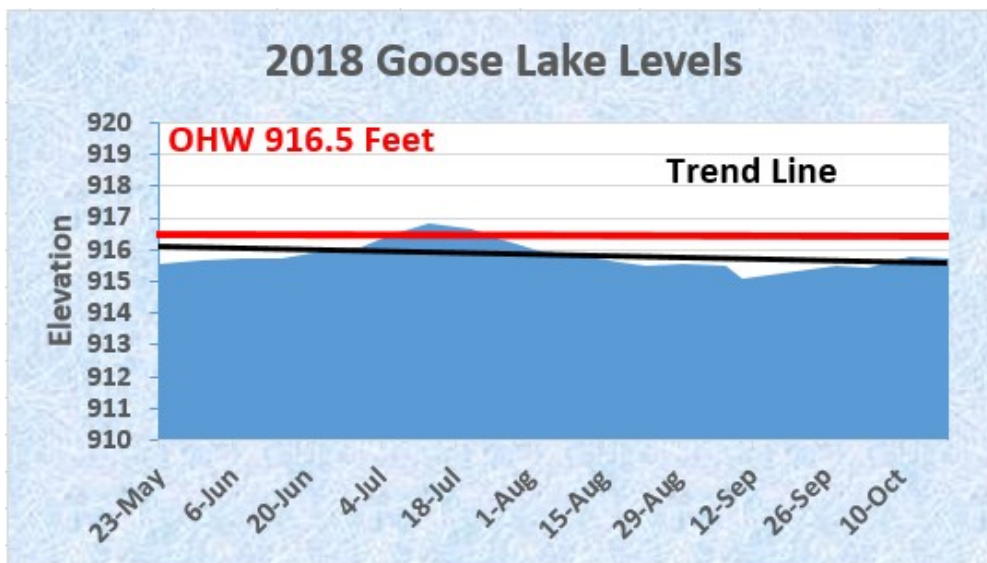


CHISAGO COUNTY LAKE LEVEL MONITORING PROGRAM

In addition to the 15 Lake Level gauges located in the Chisago Lakes Lake Improvement District, Chisago County Staff and volunteers monitor two Lake Level gauges located in the northern portion of Chisago County each week during open water season to determine if the lakes are approaching high water levels. Water levels are reported to the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) for their database.

Goose and Rush Lakes exceeded the Ordinary High Water (OHW) level in 2018 and the Slow No-Wake ordinance restrictions were in place during these times. The Slow No-Wake ordinance temporarily restricts boat speeds within 300 feet of shore during high water conditions and permanently restricts boat speeds in many channels connecting the lakes.
