CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

RE: CR 63 (Brunswick Rd) Reconditioning Project – CR 8 (Cedarcrest Trl) to CR 7 (Rush Point Drive)

Dear Property Owner:

As you are aware, Chisago County Public Works is working on County Road 63 from CR 8 to CR 7 this summer. This letter is to provide a little update on the schedule and process that is happening over the next couple months.

The Project was separated into two different construction operations; the first one, which is almost complete, is to install new roadway culverts that are in poor condition and are in need of replacement. The Contractor anticipates completion of this work by the end of next week or early the following. In order to do this work, the Contractor will need to close the road at various locations to replace large culverts. Specific of these closures are provided below:

- Tuesday June 23rd – Road closed 900 feet East of Anchor Ave. on Brunswick Ave.
- Wednesday June 24th – Road closed 1200 feet East of Acorn Ave. on Brunswick Ave.
- Thursday June 25th – Road closed 100 feet West of Alpine Ave. on Brunswick Ave.

The second operation will be to reclaim (grind) the existing roadway surface, add a sand section to the road between 440th Street and Anchor Ave., grade, and place new pavement on the roadway. This work is anticipated to start Monday July 6th, 2020 with the following schedule:

- July 6th – July 23rd Road correction work between 440th Street and Anchor Avenue.
- July 21st – July 27rd Reclaim (grind) and grade the existing road surface
- July 28th – Aug 4th Pave roadway
- Aug 5th – Aug 10th Shoulder and pavement markings

Any non-swing away style mailboxes will be replaced with new swing away style mailboxes after paving as well.

During construction local access to homes and businesses will be maintained. There will be times when access to your driveway will be limited, but we will work closely with you and the contractor to provide proper notification through these instances. Our goal is to complete the project on time and on budget as well making sure our residents are taken care of.
