Lake Level Monitoring Program

Chisago County Staff and volunteers monitor three Lake Level gauges located in the northern portion of Chisago County each week during open water season to determine if the lakes are approaching high water levels.

Water levels are reported to the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) for their database and also posted on the Chisago County website at

Slow-No-Wake Ordinance

Fish, Little, School and Wallmark Lakes exceeded the Ordinary High Water (OHW) level in 2020 and the Slow-No-Wake ordinance restrictions were in place during these times.

The Slow-No-Wake ordinance temporarily restricts boat speeds within 300 feet of shore during high water conditions and permanently restricts boat speeds in many channels connecting the lakes, and establishes Bull Lake as a non-motorized lake.
